## ACCOLADES FOR CABERNET SAUVIGNON

### 2014 VINTAGE

93 Points – John Schreiner

*“The great 2014 vintage has produced superb reds, among them this rich and concentrated Cabernet Sauvignon. The wine begins with aromas of cassia and vanilla and goes on to show flavours of black cherry, plum, fig and dark chocolate. The long, ripe tannins give the wine a satisfying elegance. This is a cellar-worthy Okanagan Cabernet Sauvignon.”*

93 Points – Michael Lowe

*“This big, rich red is packed with ripe blackberry and plum with notes of smoke, tobacco, spicy cedar and vanilla. A complex wine that is lush and beautifully textured with good length on the palate. If you can't wait another 5-8 years of cellar time, decant it for a couple of hours and let it envelop the senses.”*

4½ Stars – Vic Harradine

*“Lifted aromas of baking spice, local wild herbs and dark bramble berry provide segue to a wide swath of flavour muscling across the palate with plenty of heft, flavour and charm—black currant, dark raisins and black, juicy Bing cherry decorated with flecks of vanilla. This is full bodied, fully textured and full flavoured with a lengthy, dry finish and aftertaste. Drink now after a three-hour aeration/decant and on to 2025”*

### 2013 VINTAGE

90 points – John Schreiner

*“The wine was aged 16 months in French oak barrels (64% new). This begins with classic varietal aromas of cassia, blackberry and spice. On the palate, there are flavours of black currant with hints of espresso and black olive. The texture is firm, thanks to both the ripe tannins and the minerality. The wine benefits from decanting but patient consumers would be advised to cellar this at least to 2020.”*
